SP1 Scope

- to finally pave the way towards implementation of the solutions delivered by the project.



SP1 Objectives

SP1 aims to guarantee proper diffusion of knowledge and projects results inside and outside the consortium. It's vital to promote the project involving

- **the project partners** to exchange knowledge,
- **the end users** to achieve sector acceptance of the project results and ensure that final implementation will be possible,
- **the stakeholders outside the consortium:** national and EU authorities, standardisation bodies, external industry, external academic community,
- **the commission** to be provided with deliverables,
- **general public** to be informed.



SP1 Organisation

- **Leader UIC**
 - UIC represents the whole railway sector : Infrastructure Managers, railways undertakings, rail service providers...
- **Co-leader UNIFE**
 - UNIFE represents industry suppliers
- **Dissemination Board** (composed by one representative from each beneficiary organization) :
 - supervise the dissemination strategy;
 - assess the sensitivity of all deliverables before publication.
